Inductive Bible Study Worksheet

An inductive Bible study involves deductive reasoning (*the process of reasoning from one or more statements (premises) to reach a logically certain conclusion*) it typically takes three steps in the process: observation, interpretation, and application. An inductive study is seeking to supply strong evidence for the truth of the conclusion. Select any scripture from today's lesson and follow all the steps listed in this worksheet.

I. OBSERVATION

Author? The apostle Paul

Audience? Timothy

What is happening? The apostle paul is writing to Timothy.

Where is this happening? In Rome

When is this happening? Between AD 66 or 67

Why is this happening? Because Paul is worning Timothy.

How is this happening? Through the written letters to Timothy
