An inductive Bible study involves deductive reasoning (the process of reasoning from one or more statements (premises) to reach a logically certain conclusion) it typically takes three steps in the process: observation, interpretation, and application. An inductive study is seeking to supply strong evidence for the truth of the conclusion. Select any scripture from today's lesson and follow all the steps listed in this worksheet.

I. OBSERVATION

Author? James the half-brother of Jesus.

Audience? The 12 tribes scattered among the nations.

What is happening? the author James is teaching about a heavenly father his gifts and principles of Godly living.

Where is this happening? In a gathering among the nations.

When is this happening? Between 40 AD and 50 after Jesus ascended into Heaven.

Why is this happening? Because James a servant of Jesus Christ wants everyone to know how they should live there lifes.

How is this happening? By the preaching of a servant of Jesus Christ James.
