

How someone of faith can reconcile scientific law and process with biblical truths is by knowing their bible. For example science and the Bible supports the water cycle. The scriptures say in (*Job 36:27-29*) "For He draws up drops of water, which distill as rain from the mist, Which the clouds drop down. And pour abundantly on man. Indeed, can anyone understand the spreading of clouds. The thunder from His canopy?" The bible already gave us and our ancestors the answer to the cause of the water cycle, before it was given it's name by John Dalton. "It took well over 2000 years for a reasonable understanding of the science of hydrology to evolve. Not until the pioneering work of John Dalton in about 1800 were all the mechanisms of the large scale hydrological cycle properly determined." Thousands of years ago, the Bible mentioned all these modern concepts of hydrology in detail in various verses and included complete descriptions of the hydrologic cycle. In (*Psalms 135:7 NKJV*) scriptures say, "He causes the vapors to ascend from the ends of the earth; He makes lightning for the rain; He brings the wind out of His treasures." This makes logical sense that we can visually see, such as vapor coming down as what we know as *rain*, along with the rain there comes *lightning* as well *wind*. All things that were claimed in *Psalms 135:7* are what we visually experience. How cool is the word of God that He made the earth using *scientific law* just so we could find him. He makes lightning for the rain, He brings the wind out of His treasures." *Psalms 104:13 NASB* says, "He waters the mountains from His upper chambers; the earth is satisfied with the fruit of His works."

From all of these scriptures from *the Bible*, we see that God had already given us so much information regarding the water cycle that when scientists did their research they could *only* go in and give names and some definitions to what God had already given us.
