## **5 QUALITIES/TRAITS OF A GOOD LEADER**

1	GOOD LEADERS MUST ENVISION WHAT DOESN'T EXIST AND CLEAR DIRECTION
	TO FULFILL THE VISION.
	Habakkuk 2:2 Then the Lord answered me and said: "Write the vision and make it plain on tablets, that he may run who reads it.
	<ul> <li>Process: They see the vision, communicate it to their people, write it down, and establish strategies, goals, resources and timeline needed to fulfill vision.</li> </ul>
2.	GOOD LEADERS MUST BE ABLE TO THE PEOPLE ON THEIR TEAM.
	Note: The leader needs to be able to know their people's gifts, skills, personalities, strengths,
	weaknesses and level of development. Example: Samuel had spiritual insight to see a king in David when he was just a shepherd.
	I Samuel 16:7 Then Samuel asked, "Are these all the sons you have?" "There is still the youngest," Jesse
	replied. "But he's out in the fields watching the sheep and goats." "Send for him at once," Samuel said. "We will not sit down to eat until he arrives."
	A. A LEADER MUST BE ABLE TO SEE THE OF THOSE THEY ARE LEADING. (A leader
	must spend time with their people in order to identify and develop their potential.)
	B. THE LEADER MUST BE ABLE TO ASSESS THE LEVEL OF SPIRITUAL OF EACH
	PERSON ON THEIR TEAM.
	i. The purpose of accessing is to give assignments that they can handle.
	ii. This also helps the leader identify the level of support and training needed for them to succeed.
	Exodus 18:25-26 He chose capable men from all over Israel and appointed them as leaders over
	the people. He put them in charge of groups of one thousand, one hundred, fifty, and ten. <sup>26</sup>
	These men were always available to solve the people's common disputes. They brought the
	major cases to Moses, but they took care of the smaller matters themselves.
3.	GOOD LEADERS ARE WILLING TO PAY THEFOR THE FULFILLMENT OF THE VISION AND THE
	DEVELOPMENT OF THE PEOPLE.
	<b>Luke 14:28 (NKJV)</b> For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the
	cost, whether he has enough to finish it—
	• Potential cost = Time, finances, efforts, relationships, self-denial.
	A. A GOOD LEADER NEVER ASKS SOMEONE TO PAY A PRICE THEY ARE NOT WILLING TO THEMSELVES.
4.	GOOD LEADERS KNOW HOW TO A PLAN AND SET GOALS TO ACCOMPLISH THE VISION.
	Ingredients of a good plan include building teams, setting goals, identifying resources needed, and deadlines.
	<b>Nehemiah 2:12</b> I slipped out during the night, taking only a few others with me. I had not told anyone

about the plans God had put in my heart for Jerusalem....

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A.	GOOD LEADER'S NOT ONLY FULFILL VISION, BUT ALSO	THE SPIRITUAL WELL-BEING

5.	GOOD LEADERS MUST BE WILLING TO BE BOTH LIFELONG	AND LIFELONG
	TEACHERS.

A.	A LEADER UNDERSTANDS T	HAT IN ORDER TO LEAD OTHERS TO THE NEXT LEVEL, THEY THEMSELVES
	NEED TO BE	TO THE NEXT LEVEL OF RELATIONSHIP WITH GOD, UNDERSTANDING OF
	THE WORD, WISDOM, AND	LEVEL OF SKILL.
