THE ROCK OF OFFENSE

"Behold, I lay in Zion a chief cornerstone, elect, precious, and he who believes on Him will by no means be put to shame." Therefore, to you who believe, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, "The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone," and "a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense." They stumble, being disobedient to the word, to which they also were appointed.

—1 PETER 2:6-8

[Read chapter 9.]

TO DAY THE MEANING OF THE WORD *BELIEVE* HAS BEEN WEAKENED. In the eyes of most it has become a mere acknowledgment of a certain fact. To many it has nothing to do with obedience. But in the passage above the words *believe* and *disobedient* are represented as opposites.

The Scriptures exhort "that whoever believes in Him [Jesus Christ] should not perish but have everlasting life" (John 3:16).

As a result of the way we view the word *believe*, many think that all they are required to do is believe that Jesus existed and died on Calvary to be in good standing with God. If this were the only requirement, the demons would be in good standing with Him, for the Scriptures also say, "You believe that there is one God. You do well. Even the demons believe—and tremble!" (James 2:19). Yet, there is no salvation for them.

The word *believe* has more meaning in the Scriptures than that of acknowledging the existence of or mentally assenting to a fact. According to the context of the verse above, we can say that the element of believing is obedience. We could read it this way: "Therefore, to you who obey, He is precious; but to those who are disobedient, 'The stone which the builders rejected has become the chief cornerstone,' and 'a stone of stumbling and a rock of offense.'"
